1. About the National Shed Development Programme

The Australian Men's Sheds Association (AMSA) administers the Australian Government National Shed Development Programme (the NSDP) on behalf of the Australian Government. The aim of the programme is to provide direct financial assistance to Member and non-member Men's Sheds of the Australian Men's Shed Association across Australia with priority given to those Sheds in areas of greatest need.

Under the NSDP, the Australian Government allocates \$800,000 (GST excl) each financial year (a funding pool of \$400,000 (GST excl) per round for two funding rounds). Over the past eight years, Rounds 1-16, a total of \$4,386,285 (GST excl) has been provided to assist new and existing Sheds.

2. Categories Overview

Individual Men's Sheds (both developing and established Men's Sheds) in Australia can apply for a range of financial support across the following three funding categories:

-Category One: **Tools, Equipment, Community Projects & Training** to a maximum of \$5,000

-Category Two: **Building Maintenance & Development** to a maximum of \$7,500

-Category Three: **Health Improvement Activities** to a maximum of \$5,000

3. Round Sixteen Priorities

The priorities for Round Sixteen included:

- Applicants who applied for **Category 3 (Health Improvement Activities)** were given priority under Round 16. Applicants could apply for more than one category, up to a total of \$10,000
- Men's Sheds in areas of greatest need
- Men's Sheds who engage with and have membership from the 12 priority groups
- Applicants who have not received previous NSDP funding and can demonstrate need and engagement with the Priority Groups.
