2	Shed Improvements	Includes improvements, modifications and refurbishment	up to \$8000
3	Equipment	Requests from new Men's Sheds (<2 years old) and/or have not previously received NSDP funding or have not received funding in the past six rounds (rounds 18-23)	up to \$5000
4	Mental Health, Wellbeing and Events	Includes regional events, training, equipment to deliver mental health and wellbeing activities Resources available <i>Shed Mates Handbook</i> <i>Men's Shed Gathering and Health Event Manual Jul 2022 V4</i> <i>Health Resources Websites for Men's Sheds July 2022 (access to free resources)</i> <i>Engaging with local health services and/or providers Jul 2022</i>	up to \$8000
5	Defibrillators Separate application form	Eligibility- Do not have a defibrillator or have one purchased prior to 2016 (i.e., older than 6 years)	up to \$2250

Eligible Items

1	Health Wellbeing and Events	<p>Regional events-venue hire, catering, delegate satchels, equipment hire, marquee/gazebo, printing/stationery, whiteboard, PA system, transport and accommodation subsidies for visiting Shed members (who have had to travel a long distance) for a 2 day event</p> <p>Health Wellbeing Equipment-Computer and IT equipment (<i>to support and facilitate shed-based connectivity, online interaction, and participation in online events</i>), First aid items, health and safety equipment, PPE, Test and Tag, fitness equipment, COVID-safe equipment</p> <p>Health Wellbeing Training- First aid/CPR/defibrillator, Test and Tag, health and wellness workshops, food/chemical handling, nutrition, computer and IT, training videos</p>
2	Shed Improvements	<p>Improvements, modifications and refurbishment</p> <p>Dust extraction system, air filtration, improved access- railings, disability ramp, sealed pathway, roof repairs, guttering and downpipes, electrical or plumbing upgrades, gas installation, improved lighting, kitchen/bathroom facilities, security, work and/or storage areas such as enclosed veranda, awnings, shipping container; food growing garden beds, install roof vents, shade cloth outside shed, smoke alarms, materials, dividing walls to create new work spaces such as office, increase dining space, outdoor recreational area, Industrial wall fans, retaining walls, garden shed, solar systems, replace flooring, disabled car bay, blinds, roller doors</p>
3	<p>Equipment</p> <p>New Men's Sheds (less than 2 years old) and/or those that have not previously received NSDP funding or have not received funding in the past six rounds (rounds 18-23).</p>	<p>Hand and power tools, batteries, lathes, welding equipment, air compressors, gardening tools, arts and crafts such as leatherwork, pyrography, CNC Kit Router/Laser engraving machine, 3D printer, printer, laminator, heavy duty sewing machine, sand blast cabinet, cleaning such as wet/dry vac, HWS, kitchen equipment such as stove, cooking, refrigerator, lockable cabinets, water tank, pumps, tool chest, marquee/gazebo, electronics, pallet jack</p>
4	Mental Health, Wellbeing and Events	<p>Regional Mental Health events-venue hire, catering, delegate satchels, equipment hire, marquee/gazebo, printing/stationery, whiteboard, PA system, transport and accommodation subsidies for visiting Shed members (who have had to travel a long distance) for a 2 day event</p> <p>Mental Health and Wellbeing Equipment –Equipment related to activities to support mental health (e.g., yoga mats, meditation pillows, art therapy), COVID-safe equipment specific to a mental health and wellbeing event</p> <p>Mental Health and Wellbeing Training- Mental Health First Aid, mental wellness workshops, meditation and mindfulness courses, yoga classes, computer and IT, training videos</p>
