#### Chairman's report

We must congratulate you all on how Men's Sheds reacted to the changes, showing the true spirit of mateship within the Sheds, as even through isolation you were all looking after each other.

The year 2020 was also a year of many successes for the Men's Shed movement. The first of which was the introduction of Men's Sheds now having their own category of Deductible Gift Recipient

(DGR) status. This change in Government Legislation has been many years in the making and is a significant milestone for the future sustainability of the broader Shed movement.

AMSA would like to express our sincere gratitude to the Department of Treasury, the Australian Charities and Not for Profits Commission and the Australian Taxation Office and all of those within for working with AMSA and all stakeholders in listening to our needs and requirements. We would also like to acknowledge those within the Parliament of Australia who worked on our behalf to make this legislation happen.

Both the 'Shed Online' and the 'Shed Wireless' have been huge successes and will now become valuable assets to AMSA and Sheds which we will be continuing well into the future. The 'Shed Wireless' now has an audience of over 12,000 listeners worldwide. We would like to acknowledge Aaron Kearney for his time and efforts in presenting the program along with all of our special guests, those Sheds who have contributed as feature Sheds and most importantly all of you who listen in each fortnight to the program. This has all contributed to making the 'Shed Wireless' one of the most popular Podcasts in the country.

Importantly for the future of the Men's Shed movement, the AMSA entered into a new funding agreement with the Federal Department of Health which will ensure that we are in a position to deliver services to you well into the future. I am also pleased to inform you that as part of this new funding the National Shed Development Program will be continued with one million dollars per year allocated to these grants.

I acknowledge the AMSA staff for their professionalism, creativity, and flexibility in responding to the demands put upon them by the COVID pandemic. Thanks also to my fellow Board members for their commitment and contribution over the past 12 months.

I wish all Shedders and your loved ones a peaceful festive season and hope to see more of you shoulder to shoulder in 2021.
